Instructions:

Step 1: Open Network Settings

- 1. Access Network Settings:
 - a. Click on the Network icon located in the top-right corner of the screen.
 - b. Select Settings from the dropdown menu.

Address: Enter 172.31.255.123. Netmask: Enter 255.255.0.0. Gateway: Leave this field blank (not needed).

- 4. Save Changes:
 - a. Click Apply to save the new settings.
